



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
GUIZHOU UNIVERSITY OF TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE (GUCM)
AND
UNIVERSITY OF MUHAMMADIYAH JAKARTA, INDONESIA**

1. Introduction

Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (GUCM), having its address at China, Dusi Elevated Bridge, Nanming Qu, Guiyang Shi, Guizhou Sheng, CHINA and **UNIVERSITY OF MUHAMMADIYAH JAKARTA, INDONESIA**, having its address at Jln. KH. Ahmad Dahlan, Cirendeu, Ciputat, Jakarta Selatan, INDONESIA hereby agree to conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for academic and research cooperation based upon the principles of mutual benefit.

2. Purposes

The academic and research cooperation programs may include (but not limited to):

- a. Exchange of faculty members
- b. Exchange of students
- c. Joint research projects and activities
- d. Joint conferences and publications
- e. Special short-term Academic Programs
- f. Staff Development Programs
- g. Other programmes agreed by both Universities.

3. Implementation

- a. All activities carried out under the terms of this MOU shall be separately negotiated and determined by both universities subject to availability of resources and giving consideration to the special strengths and limitations of each faculty.
- b. Such cooperative agreements are not intended to be legally binding documents, but rather are intended to describe the nature and suggest guidelines for mutually beneficial cooperation.
- c. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the MOU.


4. Time Period

This MOU will be effective from the date of signature for an initial period of 5(five) years. Thereafter it shall be automatically extended for an additional period of five years at each expiration date unless either party provides written notice to terminate the MOU a minimum of six months prior to the expiration date.

5. Amendment

Any amendment to this MOU shall be based on the mutual consent and requires the written approval of the President/Rector/Director of each institution that shall be appended hereto. This declaration will become effective with the agreement of both parties.
